**Format:** 54 holes at stroke play. All contestants will play 18 holes on Monday and Tuesday. Players with the low 55 scores and ties will advance and play 18 holes on Wednesday, August 15. The player with the lowest 54 hole score will be the Champion. In the event of a tie, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately following the final round.

**Practice Round:** Please contact the Pro Shop directly to arrange to play a practice round. A special rate of \$35 for 18 holes with cart is available on Thursday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.

**Practice Facility:** Lyman Orchards Golf Club has a comprehensive practice facility that includes a driving range, putting greens, as well as chipping and bunker areas.

**Golf Carts:** The cart fee is \$15 per person. Spectators will not be permitted to ride in carts. Pull carts are permitted. You may carry your own bag. If another player in your group is prepared to share a cart, you are encouraged to do so. Full carts are available on a first come basis for \$25.

**Caddies:** You may bring your own caddie. Your caddie may drive your golf cart transporting your clubs at \$15 a person, if another player is not already riding with you.

**Cell Phones:** Use of all cellular phones or similar device by a contestant or caddie during a stipulated round is strictly prohibited. Breach of this policy will be considered a conduct violation and will result in **disqualification**.

**Artificial Measuring Devices:** Are prohibited. Penalty for breach of Rule 14-3 is **disqualification**.

**Dress Code:** Competitors, caddies, and spectators are expected to comply with the dress code. Inappropriate attire includes the following: denim, tank tops, tee shirts, and short shorts. Soft spikes are required at all times.

**Rules:** U.S.G.A. rules govern play, except where modified by local rules posted the day of play. There will be rules officials roving in carts on the course. If you are in doubt as to procedure, you may play a "second ball" (Rule 303). U.S.G.A. Pace of Play will be enforced. Players will be assessed a two-stroke penalty for undue delay. A repeated offense will result in disqualification.

**Resolution of Ties:** Ties for first place Championship will be broken by a hole-by-hole playoff starting on Hole # 18 immediately following the final round. All other ties for prizes will be broken by matching score cards, the winner having the best score for the last 9 holes. If the the tying players have the same score for the last nine, the winner will be determined on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes and finally the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. If there are still ties, the winner will be decided by draw.

**Starting Time:** Competitors must report to the registration table **ATLEAST 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO THEIR START TIME**. The player shall start at the time designated by the Committee. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3 is disqualification. Any individual withdrawing after the pairings have been made may be prohibited from entering the Tournament the following year after review by the Committee.

From points north take 91 south to Exit 18, left onto Rt 68, follow to Rt 157, take left per above.
