Proposed Amendments to SNEWGA Constitution:

Article V, Section 8. The Executive Committee, as it deems necessary, shall propose amendments to this Constitution for consideration and action by the membership at an annual meeting.

Article VII, Section 5. Representation by a majority of the member clubs shall constitute a quorum.

Article IX AMENDMENTS

The Constitution may be amended at the annual meetings by a two-thirds vote of those present and authorized to cast ballots under Article VII, Section 4. The Secretary shall provide member clubs with written notice of any proposed amendments not less than thirty days prior to the meeting at which an amendment will be considered.
