NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS AND THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION.

FORMAT: 54 hole individual stroke play. The Champion will be determined by the low 54 hole score. In the event of a tie, the Champion will be determined by a hole by hole playoff immediately following play. Holes 10, 11 and 12 will be played in sequence until a Champion is determined.

TEES: Play will be from the Oronoque Country Club gold tee markers.

HOLE LOCATIONS: Hole location sheets will be available each day at reception and at the starter's table.

CONDITIONS: Per the Letter to Contestants, the players are reminded that the following are in effect: Cellular Phones, Footwear and Dress Code. If you have any questions, please inquire at reception or at the starter's table.

PACE OF PLAY: CSGA Pace of Play Guidelines are in effect. The hole by hole pace of play requirements will be marked on each player's scorecard. Failure to observe these requirements will result in penalty.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: All on course decorative plantings are considered ground under repair from which play is prohibited. Free relief is mandatory.

STONE WALLS: On course stone walls and rocks are considered to be integral parts of the course. There is no free relief.

OUT OF BOUNDS: This course winds through a residential community and there are many OB areas. These areas are marked by white stakes, decorative lamp posts and white paint lines. The lampposts marking out of bounds are OB stakes from which no free relief is allowed. A ball on or over any roadway is OB. The clubhouse parking lot is OB. In the event of any doubt about the location of a ball, play of a provisional ball is encouraged.

OB left on holes #1, #9, #10 and #11.

OB left and right on holes #2, #3, #4, #5, #8, #12, #13, #14, #15, #16, #17 and #18

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS: Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red lines or stakes.

Hole #1 – Right side near green

Hole #3 – Drop Area is available as an additional option

Hole #9 - Right side of fairway.

Hole #16 – Left of green

Hole #17 – Left side – a Drop Area is available as an additional option

ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREA: The area on the right side of the 9th hole is an Environmentally Sensitive Area that is defined by red stakes with green tops as a Lateral Water Hazard from which play is prohibited. See the Rules of Golf, Appendix I, Part B, Section 2b.

YARDAGE MARKINGS: There are markers in the fairway that indicate 100, 150 and 200 yards. Measurements are to the center of the green. Devices that measure distance only are permitted. See the Rules of Golf, Appendix I, Part B, Section 9.

OTHER NOTES:

- Players are asked to be at their starting tee 10 minutes before their starting time.
- Food and beverages are available all day on a cash basis.
- Return scorecards **immediately** upon completion of play to the scorers' table located under the portico at the front of the clubhouse.
